Qualification and Certification	On successful completion of the qualification, a Certificate holder with five years' experience in a Health and Safety role may apply for Technician membership (Tech IOSH) of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). The Certificate also satisfies the academic requirements for Associate membership (AIIRSM) of the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management. Delegates who attend and successfully complete both written examinations (IGC1 and GC2) and the practical assessment (IGC3) will be awarded a certificate from the National Examination Board for Occupational Safety and Health (NEBOSH).
